

## **Come Out of Her, My People**

And upon her forehead *was* a name written,  
MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS  
AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.

Rev 17:5

And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people,  
that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.

Rev 18:4

Speculation about where Mystery Babylon is or what city it is has abounded over the centuries since the Revelation to John was written late in the first century. Vatican City, New York, Jerusalem, even Babylon itself, have all been put forth as possibilities, but all of these locate Mystery Babylon in a certain place. While I believe Mystery Babylon does indeed have a central control center located in a city, Mystery Babylon is a system, not a place. It is a centralized, spiritually controlled human system, and is more powerful than any government on the face of the earth, including that of the United States. When Mystery Babylon speaks, Kings and presidents bow down and listen. If they refuse to listen, they will soon tremble for their lives. Remember JFK? The only human beings able to stand up against Mystery Babylon are the servants of the Living God—those who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit (Rom 8:1). Only the power of God himself, appropriated by humans as they obey His commands, is powerful enough to resist Mystery Babylon with success.

Mystery Babylon is the control system that directs the governments of the world to support the New World Order (NWO), as described throughout the Revelation to John. Hidden for centuries behind the mask of diplomacy and statecraft, Mystery Babylon dictates to presidents and prime ministers what their foreign policy will be, what their budgets will be, and what their military will do. As we get close to the realization of this NWO, Mystery Babylon doesn't feel the need to hide itself as thoroughly as it has in the past. Its power has grown to where it can now do things with impunity. Note Barak Obama's designation of czars for various government functions. There is no constitutional authority for these positions whatsoever, yet congress doesn't say anything about it and the courts are silent. So the constitutional violation continues unabated.

The clearest sign of this system called Mystery Babylon is the fact that the governments of the world, supposedly working for the benefit of the people they represent, obviously work against those people. In France, government policies allow Muslims to multiply without restraint, obviously against the wishes of most Frenchmen. In the United States, the government allows an illegal alien invasion without raising a finger to stop it, despite the outspoken desire of most Americans to stop it. The situation is the same around the world. It would take a relatively simple change of attitude to genuinely benefit the people they represent, yet most governments insist on pursuing policies that are not only harmful to their people, but feed into the NWO control system. Mystery Babylon is intent on creating a master/slave relationship between the governments of the world and the people who live in the world. Guess who we are? We're the slaves, in case you didn't catch that.

This control system is embedded in every society on earth, very deeply embedded in modern societies. I live in America, so I can address our part of this system, but I strongly suspect it is very similar around the rest of the world, no matter what country you are in. You could live in a little, backward,

third-world country and the system will be there. This system has three aspects to it: economic, political, and religious. The political system compares to the brain, the economic system to the blood, or circulation, and the religious system to the heart. Controlling all three aspects puts the NWO in control of everyone on this earth.

The fact that most governments have cozy relationships with big business that do not benefit the general population is a clear indicator of this control system. People need to eat and use natural resources, and the big corporations have learned how to control food and natural resources (Monsanto, Archer Daniels Midland, DuPont, etc.). They are big enough to shut down serious competition and strategically pay off government officials so as to maintain control over entire economies under the guise of 'helping the economy'. They have the money for fancy PR campaigns to convince the general population they are helping, rather than hurting, them.

Political systems throughout the world are hopelessly corrupt. Name a country and you can find political officials and elected representatives who will sell their soul for gain or pleasure, if they haven't already. As a matter of fact, you'll have a hard time finding an honest one. A lot of people think this corruption is a simple result of human nature, but they fail to see how well the corruption among countries and corporations is coordinated. Human nature is obviously exploited to facilitate this control system, but the control system grows as human nature is exploited. The graft and corruption would tend to be localized if it was just an issue of human nature, but this problem is global. The corruption is international, and it brings together all governments of the world under one system. Just try defying it after you've been part of it and see how quickly you get squashed like a bug. Human nature wouldn't care. The NWO control system does.

The religious system is a lot more subtle than the political and economic systems. For years we have known about new-age religion as an esoteric, 'out-there' kind of pagan religion that is into eastern spirituality, nature, and the occult. Although as Christians we might think it harmful to individuals, we didn't see it as an imminent threat to society or the economic system. Now, however, the political system is pushing 'Green' with religious fervor, making the case for global warming, and tying these things to new age religion by saying they are a threat to our existence. The entire world *must* buy into the new age ecologists' world view in order to save the world from extinction. Whether it's population control, threats to the environment, global warming, or something else, it requires the cooperation of everyone on the planet, and new-age religion preaches that gospel of salvation. Whether Hindu, Moslem, Christian, Buddhist, or Wiccan, we can all agree on saving the earth, and new age religion brings us together in that cause.

Most Christians don't worry about new age religion, but we are now getting to the point where the tenets of modern political correctness are being codified into law. Those tenets are at the core of new age religion. At this point, we can't ignore it any more. We will soon have cap and trade and God knows what other laws that will bleed our economy dry and put us all into poverty. The next step is making a religious case for all this nonsense. As these things are codified into law, Christianity will become illegal. The Bible teaches stewardship of the earth, not worship of it, and puts mankind as the crown of God's creation. Population expansion is the biblical approach to population issues (multiply and replenish the earth. Gen 1:28). Animals are to be used for human purposes. All of these things are directly contrary to modern political correctness. As these laws are passed, Christians will be jailed for

simply preaching the gospel or stating their opinion, and we have already seen that happen in the US and Canada. Other countries are far worse. More of this is coming.

So how deep does this system go? Using terrorism along with global warming and other imminent threats to our existence as justification, laws have been passed that bring us all under the control system. The government now has the legal power to fish around on our computers without our permission, watch us wherever we drive, track our purchases, and require a passport for travel. Does this sound like 'your papers, please?' from Nazi Germany? I think it does. Not only that, but Homeland Security also has 'Clergy Response Teams'. They have recruited pastors to agree to 'calm their flock' in case of an emergency, and use Romans 13 as a pretext for getting their congregations to cooperate with the government. This is what happened after hurricane Katrina. What this means is that at the very point when resistance to tyranny is necessary, vast numbers of people will be deceived into cooperating with the very government that is enslaving them.

Why would a pastor agree to calm his flock in response to a national emergency rather than directing his people to take care of themselves? Because he believes in obeying the government, pursuing a peaceful life, and being a good citizen. Naturally, he wants his flock to be good citizens. There is nothing wrong with being a good citizen, but this illustrates a fundamental misunderstanding of government. The government's purpose is to protect and defend the people it represents, and it is not doing that. If it was, the border would be shut down, Osama Bin Laden would be in jail, and the Iraq war would be over with. The pastor is a good guy and is merely trying to do his job according to his understanding of scripture. What he doesn't realize is that he is participating in a much larger system that has a purpose diametrically opposed to the scriptures he teaches. As a matter of fact, the scriptures talk about this system.

It is because the modern church has succumbed to being muzzled by 501(c)3 rules, and has adopted western culture, that it is unable to see the tar pit it has gotten itself into. Christians, innocent and law-abiding as most are, trust their government to protect them. They expect their elected and spiritual leaders to act in their best interest, so they can go about living their lives without interference. However, God requires his people to fight against evil. We do not have the option of ignoring evil or accepting it as part of our environment. While Christians go about living their lives in peace and their pastors admonish them to be good Christians, abortion continues almost unabated. Sexual slavery is increasing all over the world, and it is also increasing in the United States. Pedophiles run loose all over the land with the protection of the Roman Catholic Church. Law enforcement gets caught in illegal schemes, and uses overwhelming force to subdue minor criminals, and frequently people who are completely innocent. Elected officials are caught in their corruption on a regular basis. The list of evils is endless, and children are all too frequently the victims of this evil. How often do we hear pastors preach against these things? I don't hear it very often, if at all. If I do hear it, it's a mention in passing with no intent to stop the evil.

Can we honestly say the Church has no business speaking out on these things? Why do Christians ignore these things and just go about their daily business? Well, it would be upsetting and disruptive to speak out on these things. It would be political. It would offend people. It would make people uncomfortable. People might leave the Church and stop contributing. God forbid, the ACLU might sue us. Pastors are concerned for the the spiritual welfare of their congregation, not political causes, so

they continue their mealy-mouthed preaching on being a good Christian while they ignore the abortion clinic next door, or they choose to allow a known pedophile to run around loose in the church because it would be too politically damaging to remove him from the Church. And rather than preach what the Bible says about a current political issue, they say 'we don't get involved in politics'. So while pastors and Churches continue teaching about being a good Christian, civilization crumbles around them and freedom takes wing to the Elysian Fields. Do they know how many members of their congregations are being abused, beaten, or used as sex slaves? Do they care? Do they know any members of law enforcement who are participating in unconstitutional raids on members of their congregation? Do they even care? Pastors will almost always side with law enforcement, but what if law enforcement is violating the constitution and destroying people's rights? Pastors will side with law enforcement and the government before they stand up for Biblical principles of freedom and self-determination. They are part of the system the Bible teaches against.

The nature of Institutional Churches is to abide by the law and support the government. They exist as creatures of the government, because almost all of them are 501(c)3 organizations. They have agreed to abide by the government's rules, and when the government tells them to obey, they do. They have inadvertently put the government above the Bible they have sworn to preach. No pastor will admit to that, but if the IRS tells him he can't preach on politics, he will obey the IRS. He will not preach on politics even if doing so will stop an obvious evil. He is afraid of IRS retribution against his church. Because the Church obeys the government and its increasingly evil system, it has become part of the system. That system is Mystery Babylon.

So how do we obey the divine mandate to 'come out of her, my people'? The Institutional Church will not change, so the only option is to leave the Institutional Church. As long as there is a building with an official pastor who is acknowledged as the leader of its congregation, you have an Institutional Church, even if you're meeting in someone's home. That pastor is a control point for Mystery Babylon. He can be manipulated, and because he is trusted by the believers who follow him, he is doubly dangerous to them. This is part of the system that Mystery Babylon controls. Over the centuries it has usually had a light touch so as not to alarm those it controls, but that light touch is now turning to a heavy hand. Pastors will find it increasingly difficult to represent Christ as the government dictates more and more requirements to Institutional Churches.

Believers in developed countries must begin to form house churches, as our persecuted brothers and sisters around the world have done. This is the form the church of Jesus Christ takes when it is stripped of worldliness. We must stand for truth and righteousness, whatever the cost. We do not have the option of ignoring abortion clinics, accepting unrighteous leadership, and avoiding God's command to do righteousness.
